### Goals and philosophies of the Clover Kid program:

**Display exhibits in Christy 4-H Hall** (Check-in July 19 and July 20) – Clover Kids have the opportunity to bring projects and speak with an adult volunteer about them. All projects receive a participation ribbon and will be kept on display until Wednesday, July 27 at 6:30 pm. Third graders will need to attach a write-up with their exhibits. **Each exhibit write-up should answer the following three questions:**

What was your exhibit goal(s)? (What did you want to learn or do?)

What steps did you take to learn or do this?

What were the most important things you learned?

**Clover Kid Show and Tell** (Sunday, July 24 at 1:00 pm in the Christy 4-H Hall.) All Clover Kids and their families are invited to attend the Show and Tell and share information about their favorite project.

**Great Gardener's Fest** (Saturday, July 23 at 11:00 pm in Christy 4-H Hall) – Bring a potted plant to show and speak with an adult volunteer about your project. All projects receive a participation ribbon.

**Clover Kid Clothing Selection** (Saturday, July 16 at Christy 4-H Hall in Nevada, time TBA) – Clover Kids may participate in either Clothing Selection or \$15 Challenge.

**Clover Kid \$15 Challenge** (Saturday, July 16 at Christy 4-H Hall in Nevada, time TBA) – Clover Kids may participate in either Clothing Selection or \$15 Challenge.
